The Successful Candidates to Receive the Fast Track Graduate Scholarship for International Students for the Master of Science in Design, Business and Technology Management (English Program), Academic year 2021

According to the faculty announcement dated 13 September 2021 on the Fast Track Graduate Scholarship for International Students for the Master of Science in Design, Business and Technology Management (English Program), the selection process has now been completed and the successful candidates are:

The selected students have to be compliant to all the following conditions.

- 1. The student must has accumulated grade point average (GPAX) not lower than 3.00 and must not have any "U", "F", or "W" results in the official transcript. In case that GPAX is lower than 3.00 in any semester, student shall be suspended from receiving the scholarship in the following semester.
- 2. The scholarship covers only tuition fees. Student is not allowed to register more credits than suggested by the program.
- 3. The student is obligated to dedicate to any activities organized by the Design, Business and Technology Management Program for at least 24 accumulated hours per semester.
- 4. The student have to follow all disciplinary rules. Violation would make the student disqualified for scholarship. In that case, the paid tuition fee have to be reimbursed within 30 days.
- 5. The student who withdraw from any courses, have to pay the tuition fee of such withdrawn courses back to the Design, Business and Technology Management Program within 30 days.
- 6. Any other matters shall be under the ultimate decision of the director of the Design, Business and Technology Management Program.
