Qualifications of Applicants

1. Plan 1.1 (Thesis)

- The applicant must hold a Master's degree in related fields in the built environment, for example, Architecture, Interior Architecture, Urban Environmental Planning and Development, Urban Design, Landscape, and Innovative Real Estate Development.
- The applicant must have a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.25 on a 4.0 scale from a university or academic institutions accredited by Thammasat University Council.
- The applicant must have research experience in the related field of your dissertation topic or have already completed the related course of advanced research methodology.

2. Plan 2.1 (Thesis and coursework)

- The applicant must have at least a 3.25 cumulative grade point average on a 4.00 scale from a university accredited by the University Council or have at least three years of experience working in the field of research or profession related to the built environment (please attach supporting documents). Your study plan must be approved by the program committee.

3. Plan 2.2 (Thesis and coursework)

- The applicant must hold a Bachelor's degree in related fields in the built environment, for example, Architecture, Interior Architecture, Urban Environmental Planning and Development, Urban Design, Landscape, and Innovative Real Estate Development.
- The applicant must have a composite GPA of 3.50 or a first-class honors or a second-class honors from an accredited university.

Application Documents

1. Application Form which is signed in every page; attach 1-inch photograph.
2. A copy of certified Thai Citizen ID Card or Passport if non Thai Citizen.
3. A copy of certified Graduate Master Degree Transcript.
4. Applicants, who have earned a degree in Thai program, must submit the required TU-GET, TOEFL or IELTS. (The test date must be within the previous 2 years before application date). Applicants who have English proficiency scores higher than 550 (TU-Get), 550 (TOEFL paper-based), 213 (TOEFL computer-based) / 79 (TOEFL internet-based), 6.5 (IELTS) can submit the results as part of their graduation requirements.
5. Two letters of Confidential Recommendation.
6. Three pages of thesis proposal outline, including research title, background and rationale, objectives, conceptual framework, review of related literatures, research methodology, expected benefits and application and references.
7. Payment slip.

Criteria of Selection

1. The applicant must pass both a research proposal oral presentation and interview.
2. The applicant must have a dissertation adviser (Program instructor).
3. The applicant whose first language is not English must provide evidence of English proficiency by submitting the TU-GET or TOEFL or IELTS score (score reports are valid for two years).
4. The applicant must make a decision on a study plan and submit a research proposal.
5. Other qualifications must be in accordance with the regulations of Thammasat University or Faculty of Architecture and Planning regarding graduate studies.
