- iBT TOEFL score at a minimum of 79 or IELTS score at a minimum of 6.5 to apply for the exchange program (the scores must also reach the requirement of Partner Universities)

#### **6. Terms & Conditions:**

- 6.1 Students who apply for the Exchange Program are responsible for knowing policies and procedures regarding the award of credit for coursework completed at Partner Universities.
- 6.2 Students in the Exchange Program are required to earn minimum credits from Host University and Thammasat University.
- 6.3 Students in the exchange program are representatives for the DBTM Program. They are required to participate in promotional activities at the Host University for the duration of the experience and agree to abide by the rules and regulations of the host institution.
- 6.4 If a student withdraws from the Exchange Program after being nominated to the Host University, without valid reasons, he/she will be penalized or fined according to the terms specified in the contract.
